Parking

Please park in the western side of the lot. This keeps our parking closest to our main entrance accessible for pets and their people who are entering our veterinary clinic, and for potential adopters.

Attire

Please wear clothes that will enable you to move comfortably, and that you don't mind getting dirty. Closed-toe shoes are required.

While most of our planned activities are indoors, we may have a specific need during your group experience for a portion of the time to be outside. For this reason, we recommend that you bring sunscreen and hats during warmer months.

Volunteer Waivers

Each participant will be required to complete a volunteer waiver before the session begins. For participants aged 15-17, a parent/guardian waiver must be signed in advance and brought along with the participant. This program does not accept participants younger than 15 years of age.



Please Bring

Your own bottled water, coffee, etc. We do have vending machines and water fountains on site.
