SCARY SOUNDS

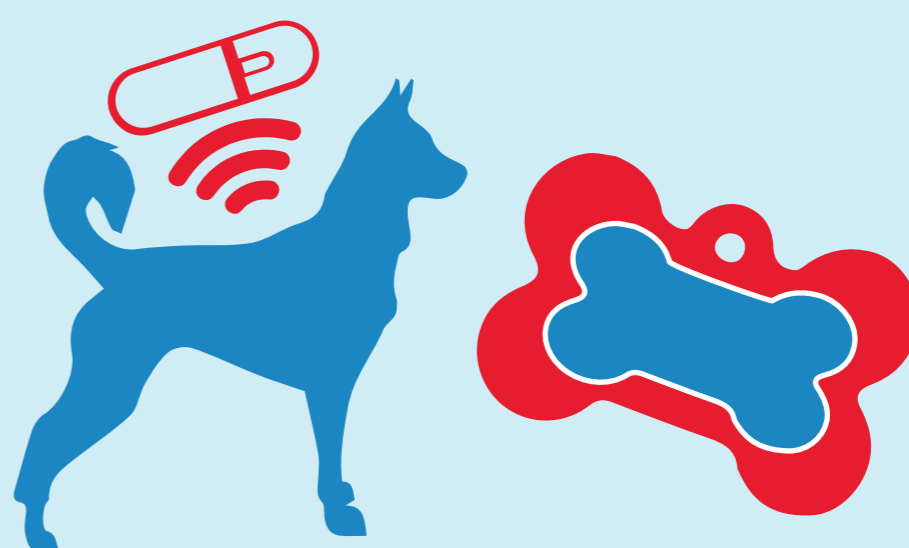
Fireworks can be extremely stressful on your pets

ID PLEASE

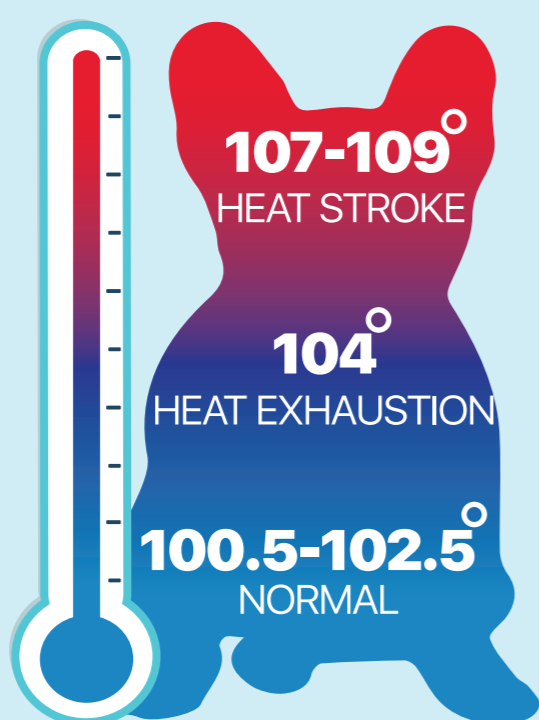
Missing pets skyrocket between July 4-6
