## Finding a Trainer for Your Pet



Identifying a trainer for your dog is not a task to be taken lightly. Currently there is no standard certifying body for dog trainers. There is no state licensure. There is no oversight of trainers that can ensure they train using only safe, appropriate science-based techniques. Inappropriate outdated techniques can cause lasting harm to your dog and to your relationship with your dog.

Many training techniques can suppress the initial presenting behavior, so they appear to be effective. If the underlying motivation for the behavior—is not changed then these same techniques can often lead to a sudden onset of even more severe problems. Aversive techniques have also been—shown to increase fear, anxiety and stress, and can lead to aggression.
