Make sure you & your furry friends are ready for Strut Your Mutt by using this checklist:

Share and Motivate

During the weeks leading up to the event, share your page and motivate others to join in on the fun! Remind people of the huge impact that they can make on the lives of the animals by participating and donating.

Prepare Your Pet

Be sure all pets that are participating in the event are properly prepared. There will be doggy pools and water bowls, but pets still need to be conditioned for the event. Depending on the weather, you may want to consider leaving your pup at home if your dog is not used to the heat, is elderly, very young, or is a breed with a short nose, such as a Pug or a Boxer. Be sure to check out our **Pet Safety Guide** to make sure your pet stays safe at the event (and all year around)!

The Week Before

Review the event details on our website carefully and make sure you are up to date on all of the logistical details! Make sure you are aware of your Packet Pick-Up day/time so that you can pick up your t-shirt, bib, and doggy bandana (if needed) ahead of time and skip the registration lines the day of the event!

Please note: Participants CAN pick up for their team members. They will simply need their first and last name(s).

Get Organized

Does your pet have a well fitting collar and ID tags? Are you meeting up with team members at the event? Make sure you are prepared and ready ahead of time for a stress-free day!
