I'm excited to be a member of the 2026 SPCA of Texas Strut Your Mutt Committee. The SPCA's mission is to create a brighter future for animals, people, and the communities we share.

One of the most exciting ways they bring that mission to life is through this walk, it's the SPCA's largest community event of the year and brings together animal lovers, families, and neighborhoods from across North Texas, all walking and working together to make a difference.

This year, we're taking that community spirit even further by introducing a new neighborhood program! We're inviting HOAs, neighborhood associations, and local friend groups to join the fun by forming neighborhood teams. Here's the best part, you don't even have to attend the walk to participate! Any neighbor who donates \$XX (we suggest a minimum donation of \$25) receives a Strut Your Mutt yard sign to proudly display and show their support for animals in need. For groups that raise \$2,500 or more the SPCA will give back to our neighborhood with a community improvement donation. That could be something like a pet microchip scanner for animals found in the area, a new dog waste station, or another project that helps keep pets and people safe and connected!

Please note that we ask for one person on the HOA to lead the charge, they sign up as "Plano HOA" (example) and that "team captain" collect donations for their "team", which can be processed directly through their team website if they want to make a credit card donation, other neighbors aren't required to join/sign up unless they would like to (and of course they are more than welcome!)
