GETTING STARTED!






LEAD BY EXAMPLE

TO HELP YOU REACH YOUR GOAL!

Here are some fundraising ideas to help you think outside of the box when fundraising for both your personal and team goals!

IDEA #1: Sell company/team/etc. t-shirts to raise money
